


Got Language?



Pomo and Miwok Language Apps Now Available Free Downloads in the App Store



The California Indian Museum and Cultural Center (CIMCC) has teamed up with Miromaa Aboriginal Language and Technology Center and Tribal Community Language Advocates to create six new language learning tools. The apps are part of the *Shoh Yehaelim Project* (Pomo is Happening Now) and was funded by the Administration for Native Americans, Department of Health and Human Services. Administration for Children and Families.

The available apps include: Bahtssal (Eastern Pomo), Southern Pomo, Northern Pomo, Central Pomo, Kanwin Tamal Words and Kanwin Tamal Phrases.
