Whether you want to pursue secondary education and/or start a new career NYETP will assist you in planning and achieving your goals. You will be connected to mentors, community resources and gain on the job experiences through our unique internship program (preparing and launching CIMCC's California Native gift store).

Weekly topics include: evaluating strengths & setting goals, advocating for yourself & your community, wellbeing, healthy relationships, financial literacy, being an ambassador of your community & your profession, retail and hospitality 101, presenting your best self, critical job skills, and community resources.

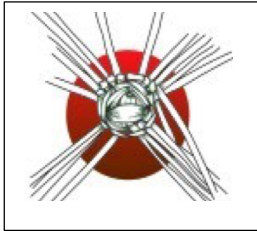
